




Distracted Driving Area of Concern


We took our long list of concerns and reduced it to our top three choices. After researching and learning more about our top three topics, one stood out and was relevant to all of us, distracted driving.


Each member of our team had specific experiences with this issue. In fact, many of us had countless examples, some of which had occurred on that actual day of our discussion or earlier in the week.




WHAT IS VISUAL DISTRACTED DRIVING


We would be happy to take both surveys.

The committee has already sent a letter to Newport High School in Bellevue, Washington, and has already received a letter back. They are hoping to share their presentation video in April. They hope to instruct multiple high schools about the numerous risks of distracted driving. They will do this by sharing two videos: one they created and one that can be found on the internet.

Also, they will give the high schoolers a survey before and a survey after their presentation. This is to see if what they have done is affecting the high schoolers. They hope to achieve a 70% decrease in distracted driving.



Awareness Sticker Committee

The Awareness Sticker Committee has made a sticker to remind drivers to keep their attention on their driving. The sticker can be placed anywhere such as water bottles, computers, and cars. This daily reminder will help to keep your eyes on the road. This will increase a drivers' focus and prevent accidents.

So far, the group has mailed letters to car companies such as Honda, Toyota, and Subaru, so they can distribute the stickers in a more effective way.





Keep Calm and Focus On the Road

Did you know even one quick look at your phone while your driving could cause a car crash? A quick look at what your brain sees you could cause an injury and maybe death? About 3,000 fatalities occur nationwide without your foot on the gas pedal. There are three main distractions that cause distracted driving. Manual, Visual, and Cognitive. Manual distractions are those where you move your hands from the wheel to do something. Visual distractions are those where you see something interesting and your eyes focus away from the road. A cognitive distraction is when your mind wanders or from the task of driving.
